



Master Bedroom Suite

THE DESIGNERS: Keven McCammon and Kitty McCammon, ASID Allied and Sita Walker, BlueRidge Design

THE THEME: A modern approach to a traditional house, the master suite brings the “grand old lady into another era.” A balance of feminine and masculine elements, it’s a place for a sophisticated couple to retreat from the hectic pace of today’s world—yet outfitted with state-of-the-art technology to keep them entertained and informed.

KEY ELEMENTS: The bold paisley print in the Ronald Redding wallpaper is subdued in its color palette, creating the impression of satin damask. Crisp tailoring and the sheen of linen give the chaise lounge its contemporary appeal. An urbane bureau, with its rich wood and soft metallic elements, was custom designed by BlueRidge and fashioned by John Fulton for the space.

JUICY DETAILS: Lush bedding and yards of diaphanous, draped fabric invite repose and soften the strong lines of the open canopy bed. The deep golden velvet of the curtain lining is revealed when wrapped around to create elegant pullbacks.

SECRET INGREDIENT: Recognizing that technology is a necessary part of daily life, the designers carefully integrated its presence into the room’s design, accommodating placement of electronics and power cords in the planning stage, rather than as an afterthought.
